The “Norwegian Forum for Offshore Survey and Positioning” (NOSP) was founded more than five years ago as a non-profit entity (registered Brønnøysund). We are extremely proud to say that, thanks to the generous financial support of our corporate sponsors, we are continuing to grow and improve as a meeting place for you and your industry colleagues. Today we have over 350 members and have an established routine of hosting informative and social evening events around the country. Each year we arrange 7 events and about 30% of respondents to a recent survey said they attend 3 or more events a year.

Our mission is to promote the offshore survey community in Norway by:

Providing a platform for social interaction, networking and information exchange;

Raising the profile of the offshore survey community within the offshore industry; and

Representing the survey profession to universities and other educational institutions.

Our website, www.NOSP.no, attracts around 1000 visits a month, where amongst other things, our sponsors are featured. 9 out of 10 of survey respondents agreed with the following two statements:

To cover the cost of our events and activities in 2019, we are again seeking annual sponsorship of NOK 10 000,- from organisations connected to the offshore survey and positioning community in Norway. Finally, the board has a vision to expand our offering to universities and young people within the industry which will be gradually launched in 2019 and hopefully be at full scale in 2020.
